While the job is primarily focused on oil and gas, due to the holistic nature of energy systems and the dynamic nature of energy transition, an understanding of clean energy and decarbonization technologies is also important.

The successful candidate must also consider how to create efficiencies for supporting the ongoing delivery of energy market fundamental data, including skills in data management, modeling, and data extraction. Proficiency with technical software, modeling and data management is needed.
